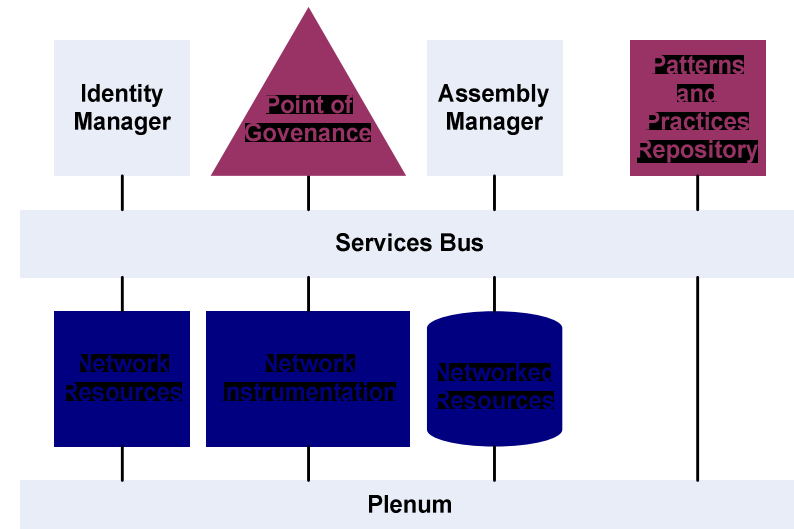

Online Governance: Motivation and Architectural Thoughts



- Service orientation in networking
 - Recognizes applications are wildly heterogeneous
 - Replace the “stack”
 - Software engineering challenges within a node
- Why online governance?
 - Applications are dynamically constructed
 - Research groups of scientists
 - Data streams being set up quickly
 - Services are important, but also create challenges, e.g., by distribution
 - Recognize diversity of ownership and construction
- How online governance?
 - Architectures for capturing and applying user requirements
 - Instrument the network properly
 - Services for management locally and interactions externally: policy; negotiation; high-level protocols
